2025 Green Plan Webinar Transcript

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Welcome to an overview of the SCHOOLCARE Green Plan. This webinar will review the features and benefits of this plan.

Slide 2 All SCHOOLCARE plans provide the same coverage. Meaning, what the plans cover for doctors, treatments and medications is the same. The Green Plan has different versions. Look at your Cigna ID card or review your benefit summary for your specific copays and out-of-pocket amounts. The plan uses Cigna's National Open Access provider network across all 50 states. The Open Access feature allows participants to self-refer to see a specialist and does not require you to name a PCP. There are no deductibles on the Green Plan and the annual medical out-of-pocket max, meaning the most you could pay for services, is capped at \$1,000 for an individual and \$2,000 for a family.

Slide 3 On the Green Plan, preventive care and certain generic drugs are covered at 100%. Office visits for PCPs, specialists and virtual care all have copays. Diagnostic services including labs, and basic radiology have no out-of-pocket cost. If you are hospitalized there also is no out-of-pocket cost. This includes inpatient services, outpatient surgery, facility charges and radiology imaging.

Slide 4 Emergency room and urgent care services are covered anywhere, in or out of network. ER and urgent care have co-pays. Other medical services such as mental health visits, chiropractic, physical and occupational therapy also have office visit co-pays. Durable medical equipment is covered at 80% leaving the patient with 20% coinsurance up to the out-of-pocket maximum.

Slide 5 Prescription drug coverage. Prescriptions follow a three-tier drug formulary which includes generic, preferred brand and non-preferred brand medications. Each tier has a copay depending on the version of the Green Plan. The annual prescription drug out-of-pocket maximum for co-pays is \$2,000 for an individual and \$4,000 for a family.

Slide 6 Cigna makes it easy to keep track of your benefits and out-of-pocket expenses. Log in to myCigna.com or the myCigna app. Once logged in, you can search for a network provider and see their ratings based on cost and quality measures. Review your claims and obtain customer service and virtual care 24/7 365 days per year. You can view details about your prescriptions as well as participate in the *Good For You!* Well-Being Program. And finally, you can view, download to your mobile wallet, or print your Cigna ID card from your myCigna account.
